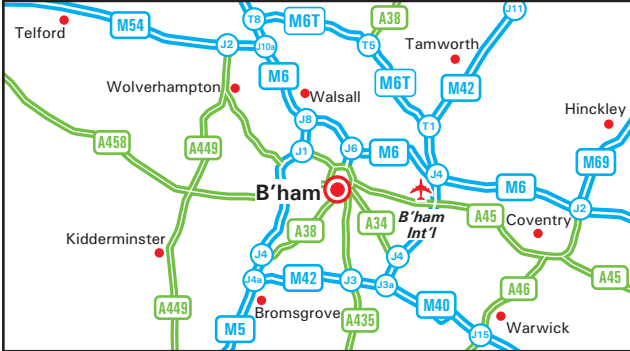

From the M6

- Leave the M6 at junction 6, and travel southbound towards Birmingham City Centre on the A38(M) - Aston Expressway.
- Follow the signs for Birmingham City Centre, continuing over the flyover, past Aston University, stay in the left hand lane.
- At the end of the flyover, move left off the A38(M) next to the Thistle Hotel.
- At the traffic island, take the second exit, under the railway bridge, then take the first left into Livery Street.
- There is a multi-storey car park at the top of Livery Street on the left hand side, or you can turn right at the end of the road into Colmore Row.
- At the pedestrian lights, continue straight on, Shoosmiths is located on the right-hand side, look for '125'.

From the M5

- Leave the M5 at junction 3 and join the A456 towards Birmingham City Centre.
- After passing the junction (Five Ways) with the A4540 continue onto Broad Street.
- At the next junction (Paradise Circus Queensway) take the second exit towards the M6, bear left onto the slip road.
- At St. Chad's Square junction, double-back passing under the railway bridge, then take the first left into Livery Street.
- Turn right at the end of the road into Colmore Row.
- Shoosmiths is located on the right-hand side, look for '125'.

Car Parking

- For Shoosmiths car park at the pedestrian lights on Colmore Row turn right into Newhall St, then take the first left into Edmund St.
- The car park is signposted, deliveries 125 Colmore Row.
- Shoosmiths car park is subject to availability/reservation.
- On street meter car parking is available in all streets surrounding Shoosmiths, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, Mon - Sat (free after 18.00 and all day Sun), maximum stay 2 hours.

By Train

- Birmingham New Street Station receives regular services from London Euston Station.
- Shoosmiths is a short walk from the station.
